This year the children will be able to participate in more sports than ever before.

The sports we cover will be gymnastics, football, tennis, unihoc, swimming, cross country, tri-golf, tag rugby, basketball, skipping and cricket within school time; to subsidised football, basketball, dodgeball, tri-golf and cricket clubs after school.

All year groups will have a gymnastic lesson each week that will last at least a half a term in length.

We will enter teams into Y3 Tri-golf, X Country in 3 different races, numerous football games, netball tournaments, swimming gala, gymnastics competition, unihoc tournament, two cricket festivals for Y3/4, two cricket tournaments for Y5/6, three football tournaments for Y3/4 and two football tournaments for Y5/6 and.
